


Total Fiscal Effort in the United States FY 2019

Technical Assistance Request – February 2023 (2)





The State of the States in Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Project is a national longitudinal comparative study of financial and programmatic trends in spending on supports and services for people with IDD in the United States. The project is funded by the U.S. Administration on Community Living as a longitudinal data project of national significance.

Fiscal effort is defined as a state's commitment to intellectual and developmental disability (IDD) services and supports after controlling for state wealth. It is a measure of spending for IDD services per \$1,000 of aggregate statewide personal income.

*The graph omits the District of Columbia with a fiscal effort of \$9.60.
